### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ❖ Auction limited to 80 head of horses, and of that, no more than 10 stallions or stud colts through the sale. Stallions will be accepted on pedigree and conformation.
- ❖ Consignments must be received by April 15, 2006. This sale will have a "selection committee" to screen consignments received. This is to ensure a high quality of horses. Once you are notified that your horse(s) have been selected, then you have till May 20, 2006 to send Original Certificate of Registration along with a proper transfer of ownership form signed by owner of record at time of consignment, the reserve, and other documents such as Breeders Certificates on mares that are in foal and other pertinent paperwork.
- ❖ Horses will sell in catalog order, designated by Sale Management.
- ❖ Once a horse is consigned to sale, Consignor agrees not to dispose of horse by private sale. Withdrawals will be permitted in hardship cases for horses that receive an injury, or have acquired an illness which prevents the horse from meeting proper health requirements.
- ❖ Reserves placed on horses CAN NOT be raised, but lowered. Once the reserve sheet has been filled out, no one may raise the reserve of their horse. This will be strictly enforced.
- ❖ Current negative Coggins test (within 1 year) and health papers (within 30 days)
- ❖ Sale Management does not act as agent for, or represent either the buyer or seller, but merely provides an environment for bringing together buyer and seller for the purpose of sale transactions. All guarantees lie solely between the Buyer and Consignor.
- ❖ Horses must be lead broke and manageable. A good halter and lead rope must accompany each horse.
- ❖ All horses must be registered AMHA OR AMHR
- ❖ The auction will provide people to lead your horse in the ring. Consignors, who wish to do this, may do so.
- ❖ Consignors are responsible for the grooming of their horse(s)
- ❖ Seller will be solely responsible for any information submitted about his/her horse.
- ❖ Double Diamond Farm reserves the right to refuse any horse for any reason.
- ❖ Consignor agrees to save and hold harmless and indemnify the Sale Management, its agents and employees from and against any and all liability, debt, claims, damages, etc.
- ❖ Seller shall receive payment of sale proceeds within 30 days following the date of sale.
- ❖ Advertising will consist of 2 full page ads in the World, A full page ad in the Journal, An ad in the Farmers Exchange, an ad in the Farmers World, 1 Mass Mailer to AMHA members, internet access to catalog.
